Summary

Information of a minor change to the location of a designated polling station

Elections staff have been made aware that the usual location for the polling place at the Armitage Church of England Primary School in Ardwick (polling district 2ARC) is the Community Room. This room has been damaged due to flooding and is now not available for use. Elections staff have agreed with the building owner to move the polling place to the 'Link Building' which is located within the school grounds. The entrance to the Link Building is on a separate road to the original site and the poll

cards for electors have been changed to reflect this. Local councillors have been informed of this change.
