QUITE A FEW.

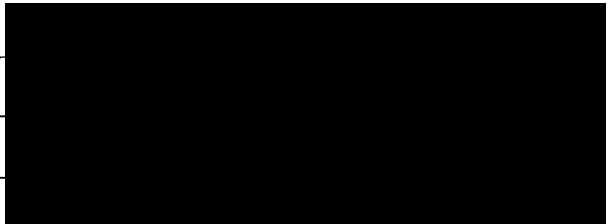

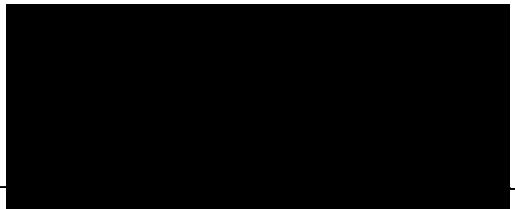



The owners, [REDACTED] are highly respected on Mansall. They arrange party's, funerals and fun days at The Queens. My Mam and brother both held their wakes there.

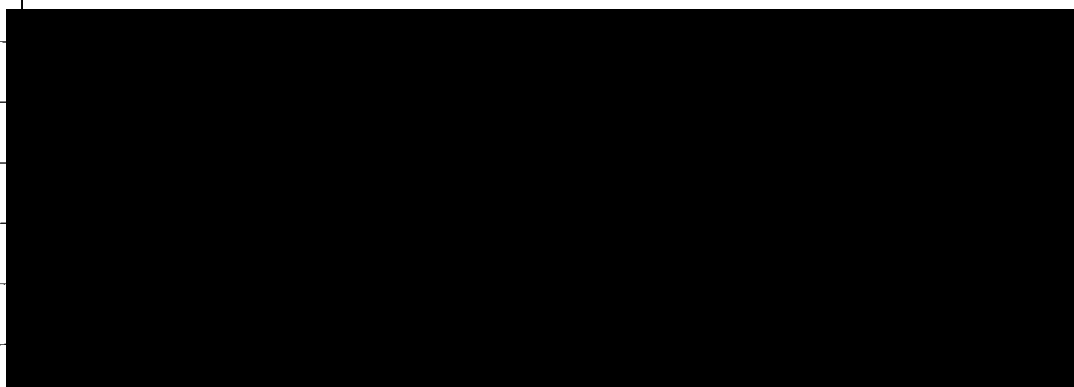
They also arrange lots of parties for the children here (obviously during the day) which is brilliant and gives them something positive as there is nothing for them to do on the estate.

The estate is not the same with them doors shut. All want to see it open again.






To whom it may concern,

I am a neighbour of the Queens Hotel, Monsall situated in [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED]

I was sad to be informed that due to a string of criminal activity the place was to be shut however I fail to see how this is supporting small local businesses to thrive when the socio economic climate is in decline and community establishments need to be available to support and give positive experiences with focus on wellbeing of the local community in general.

- o The Queens holds a weekly diet group that support the public health initiative to combat obesity in the local area
- o The Queens holds events dedicated to the Royal Family for example; Jubilee, VE day and the coronation supporting the national initiative to promote and celebrate our culture of a royal family
- o The Queens supports the nuclear family, holding many of the local community families gender reveals, birthdays, anniversaries, weddings and even deaths
- o The Queens actively engages with the community on key yearly dates giving those who do not usually engage the opportunity to entertain their families on a low budget for example Halloween, Christmas parties, mothers day events supporting with the cost of living

In general, the Queens is a hub for most people even if you do not use it as a public house but only take part in general events such as karaoke night or psychic nights or just the seasonal parties for their kids. The main point is community cohesion and engagement that benefits everyone.

The Queens has also undergone some transformation under its current management and their is a real gusto on their part to make it work and employing local people into local jobs and supporting the wider local trade to do that is a benefit to the community also.

Given the recent problems, I personally feel that the Queens is being blamed for the ineffective proactive action of the Police to do their jobs and where they feel they do not have time or finance are blaming others for their failures and that is an injustice. If you want to catch criminals then do your job, do not blame a small business for the lack of support you give it when it is indirectly supporting many community service without the funding to do so.

I would like to kindly remind the police and local services that I am positive that if the  
Queens was needed or called upon to help with community cohesion for example  
housing/councillor/MP drop ins that they would in general be supportive.

I hope the right decision is made and my points taken into consideration.

I am writing to you in regards to The Queens hotel and in particular [REDACTED]

The Queens hotel has been part of the Monsal community for over 40 years. A Family run business with the families off the estate a massive part of the community.

The [REDACTED] family have always put the local residents at the forefront of the goings on in the pub.

When Covid hit, the pub was greatly missed by the local regulars who found comfort in the pub and being one of their only places to socialise and meet with people.

When Pubs were allowed to open, [REDACTED] worked immensely and put a lot of hard work and determination into the pub to renovate it and get it back up and running just for the local residents. Working for almost 2 years through lockdown just so the Pub could reopen when pubs were allowed to do so.

[REDACTED] has put his heart and soul into the pub over the past nearly 3 years.

[REDACTED] currently has locals [REDACTED] running weekly bonus balls, Meat raffles and Games to raise as much money towards funding community days for the children of the estate.

Over the past year the pub has held very successful events for Christmas, Halloween, Easter the summer, and even the Queens jubilee entertaining more than 80 children from the local estate. The age range of these children varies from babies up to teenage years and all show massive respect to the pub and [REDACTED]

By holding these fun days at the pub, this is 80+ children off the streets and enjoying themselves in their local area, a place where everybody is respected and are growing up with the history of the pub that their parents/grandparents have grown up with, we hope that this can continue for the next generation.

Since the pub reopening, there have been a couple of occasions where drunken people have smashed the windows. [REDACTED] has dealt with the situations efficiently and professionally and those responsible have even paid for the damages caused as a rule in the pub and have apologized to [REDACTED] as he is respected and liked by all - those are now allowed back in the pub.

The pub has held many different family functions varying from, christenings, wedding, funerals, birthdays and holy communions. Without this pub there will not be anywhere for families to hold their partys or get together with everybody in the community as this is our Local.

Within the pub there is a big memorial wall dedicated to all of those lost within the community who have drank in the pub since the [REDACTED] family opened it all those years ago.



As you can see from all the above [REDACTED] has put his heart and soul into continuing his family's tradition of running an amazing pub for all local residents and without the pub it will be a part of history gone.

So as you can see, without the pub and all the help and hard work from [REDACTED] there isn't much of a community.

Please see pictures attached of fun days held in the pub [REDACTED] has been saving all funds raised through the above so that more fun days can be held in the summer and even a party for the king's coronation.
