a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

 All staff authorised to sell alcohol at the Premises shall receive appropriate training on licensing law. Records of training must be made available for inspection and copying within a reasonable time of a request by an officer of a Responsible Authority.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- The premises shall operate a CCTV system that complies with the minimum requirements of the GMP Police Licensing Team from time to time.
- There must be at least one member of trained staff at the premises during operating hours able to provide viewable copies of CCTV on request to police or authorised local authority officers as soon as is reasonably practicable in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (or any replacement legislation).
- The Challenge 25 scheme must be operated to ensure that any person
 who appears to be under the age of 25 shall provide documented proof
 that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall only comprise a
 passport, photo card driving licence, an EU/EEA national ID card or
 similar document, an HM Forces warrant card, a card bearing the PASS
 hologram, or any electronic or biometric age verification technology
 approved by the licensing authority.
- A refusals record must be kept at the premises which details all refusals to sell alcohol. This record must include the date and time of the incident, the name of the staff member who refused the sale, and the reason the sale was refused. All entries must be made within 24 hours of the refusal. The record must be made available for inspection and copying within a reasonable time of a request by an officer of a Responsible Authority.

c) Public safety

• Fire alarm, fire fighting equipment and emergency lighting systems shall be maintained at the property which comply with the latest national standards as set from time to time.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Clear and legible notices must be prominently displayed at all exits requesting customers to respect local residents and leave the area quietly.
- There shall be a 30 minute period prior to closing time where alcohol sales cease to allow for drinking up time.
- No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that gives rise to a nuisance.
- No deliveries shall take place at the premises between 10 pm and 7 am to avoid un-necessary disturbances of adjoining properties.

e) The protection of children from harm

- No unsupervised person under 16 years of age is permitted to enter or remain on the licensed premises when alcohol is being sold or supplied.
- A Challenge 25 Policy shall be enforced at the premises.

 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00
 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
