Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

The licensing objectives have been considered taking into account the nature of the premises and the proposed style of operation.

It has been taken into that the premises are located in the licensing authority's CIZ, and in particular taken into account the terms and conditions of neighbouring premises which have recently been granted a premises licence; premises which like these only provide late night refreshment as a licensable activity.

The applicant is keen to continue liaising with the liaising and other responsible authorities during the consultation period if necessary; keen to work in partnership.

The applicant has experience of successfully operating these premises late under the authority of a TEN. The TEN was issued until 5am with no objections.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A CCTV system with recording equipment shall be installed. All recordings used in conjunction with CCTV shall:

- be of evidential quality
- Cover the point of sale, and entrance and exit
- indicate the time and date
- be retained for a period of 31 days
- Sufficient staff will be trained to use the system
- The original images will be made available for inspection upon the request of Police officers, or other authorised officers.

A bound and sequentially paginated incident book or electronic record shall be kept to record all instances of disorder, damage to property and personal injury at the premises. This book shall be made available for inspection and copying by the Police or any other authorised person upon request and all such books shall be retained at the premises for at least 12 months.

A bound and sequentially paginated refusals book or electronic record must be kept at the premises to record all instances where admission or service is refused. Details to show:

- The basis of the refusal;
- The person making the decision to refuse; and
- The date and time of the refusal

Such books/records to be retained at the premises for at least 12 months, and must be made available for inspection and copying by the Police, or other officers of a Responsible Authority

c) Public safety

The premises will operate in accordance with all relevant legislation which promotes the prevention of public safety objective. For example, the Health & Safety and Food Safety legislation
The premises will liaise and co-operate with the Responsible Authorities.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
At the close of business every day staff to carry out a litter pick in the immediate vicinity of the premises.
Commercial waste not to be disposed between 22:00 -07:00
Deliveries to premises to be at a time that will not cause a nuisance.
Delivery drivers not to cause a nuisance (no horns, car doors slamming, music on).
Sign to be displayed reminding customers to leave the premises quietly.
All takeaway wrappings and containers to be marked with unique business branding.
The operator to make email and telephone number available to local residents.
