

## Schedule of Licence Conditions

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Licensee shall ensure that all times when the premises are for any licensable activity, there are sufficient competent staff on duty at the premises for the purpose of fulfilling the terms and conditions of the licence and for preventing crime and disorder.</li> <li>2. The Licensee shall ensure that all staff will undertake training in their responsibilities in relation to the sale of alcohol, particularly with regard to drunkenness and underage persons.</li> <li>3. No supply of alcohol may be made:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or,</li> <li>b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under shall be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.</li> <li>5. A responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price, which is less than the permitted price.</li> <li>6. A responsible person shall ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.</li> <li>7. The responsible person shall ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers.</li> <li>8. A full CCTV system shall be maintained and operated at the premises with cameras positioned both internally and externally.</li> <li>9. Recorded CCTV images shall be maintained and stored for a period of twenty-eight days and shall be produced to the Police or Licensing Authority upon request.</li> <li>10. CCTV shall be in operation at any time a person is in the premises. Where CCTV is recorded onto a hard drive system, any DVDs subsequently produced shall be in a format so it can be played back on a standard PC or DVD player.</li> <li>11. Any person left in charge of the premises shall be trained in the use of any such CCTV equipment, and be able to produce CCTV images to an officer from a responsible authority upon request.</li> <li>12. Plans indicating the position of CCTV cameras to be submitted to GMP prior to the premises opening.</li> <li>13. Open containers of alcohol shall not be removed from the premises, save for consumption in the delineated external area shown on the plan attached to the licence.</li> </ol>	N/A	Applicant

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<p>14. A first aid box shall be available at the premises at all times.</p> <p>15. Regular safety checks shall be carried out by staff.</p> <p>16. Management shall liaise with Greater Manchester Fire Authority as necessary to ensure compliance with all necessary fire regulations.</p> <p>17. The premises shall maintain an Incident Log and public liability insurance.</p> <p>18. Noise from the premises shall not be such as to cause a noise nuisance to occupants of nearby premises.</p> <p>19. The exterior of the building shall be cleared of litter at regular intervals.</p> <p>20. Notices shall be positioned at the exits to the building requesting customers to leave in a quiet manner.</p> <p>21. Doors and windows at the premises are to remain closed after 11pm, save for access and egress.</p> <p>22. An AI Fresco and Smoking Policy shall be implemented and adhered to</p> <p>23. Deliveries, servicing and collections, including waste collections shall not take place outside the following 0730 to 2000 Monday to Saturday. There shall be no deliveries or waste collections on Sundays or Bank Holidays.</p> <p>24. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.</p> <p>25. The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.</p> <p>26. The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy. The policy shall require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 25 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) a holographic mark, or;</li> <li>b) an ultraviolet feature.</li> </ul> <p>27. Staff training shall include the Challenge 21 and 25 Policy and its operation. In particular, staff shall be trained to take such action as is necessary to prevent the sale of alcohol to persons over the age of 18 where those customers are engaged in the distribution of alcohol to persons under the age of 18.</p> <p>28. All staff shall be regularly trained for underage sales prevention.</p>		
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29. A register of refused sales shall be kept and maintained on the premises.
