#### **Notes for Guidance**

This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

- 1. You do not have to pay a fee if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable to the late night levy.
- 2. Describe the premises, for example the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives.   - Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
  - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
  - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman
    wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed
    1000. Combined fighting sports- defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with
    one or more martial arts- are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
  - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
    - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

#### **Proposed Additional Conditions**

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

- 1. Any area where customers have legitimate access must be sufficiently illuminated for the purposes of CCTV.
- 2. CCTV must be in operation at any time a person is in the premises.
- 3. All CCTV recorded images will have sufficient clarity/quality/definition to enable facial recognition.
- 4. CCTV will be kept in an unedited format for a minumum period of 28 days.
- 5. CCTV will be maintained on a regular basis and kept in good working order at all times.
- 6. CCTV maintenance records to be kept with details of contractor used and work carried out to be recorded.
- 7. Where CCTV is recorded on to a hard drive system any DVDs subsequently produced will be in a format so it can be played back on a standard personal computer or standard DVD player.
- 8. Where CCTV is recorded onto a hard drive system, the hard drive system must have a minimum of 28 day roll over recording period.
- 9. Any person left in charge of the premises kust be trained in the use of any such CCTV equipment and able to produce/dowload/burn CCTV images upon request by a person from a responsible authority. Plans indication the position of CCTV cameras to be submitted to the responsible bodies within one week of the granting of a licence requiring CCTV.
- 10. Where the recording is on a removable medium (ie compact disc, flash card etc), a secure storage system to store those recording mediums shall be provided.
