#### Please give a general description of the premises (please read guidance note 1)

This is an application for a premises which has recently started trading and in respect of which no rateable value has been fixed. The premises recently opened under the name of Sweet!, being a sweet treats and ice cream emporium situated at the function of Stevenson Square and Lever Street.

The premises has the benefit of a Pavement Licence within the area facing into Stevenson Square, which is sought to form part of the licensed area.

The premises principal operation is the provision of dessert style foods predominantly ice cream and ice cream creations along with cakes, waffles, pancakes etc.

The premises seeks a Premises Licence to support this offer in particular the provision of alcohol tops/washes to certain ice cream or dessert offers with examples being provision of Balleys Liquer over ice cream, real Rum with Rum & Raisin ice cream etc. and creative options for pancakes and waffles.

The premises also seeks to be able to in addition to hot drinks, non alcoholic drinks, alcoholic beverages to those seated in and along the pavement ilcence area of the premises, alcoholic drinks.

The details of the area sought to be licensed are shown on drawings numbered:-

deposited with this application, those areas sought to be licensed are edged in red and are principally the current café area along with the pavement area to the front of the premises.

It is proposed that the permitted hours for licensable activities for these premises are as follows:

All areas are sought to be licensed Monday to Sunday from 09:00 until 00:00 hours internally and 09:00 to 23:00 externally in relation to retail sale of alcohol to the general public with closure 30 minutes thereafter.

The premises seeks to have an evening provision.

Conditions are proposed to address the key risk area of underage sales in view of the attractive nature to children of the nature of the premises.

It is noted that new Premises Licence applications are encouraged to add a condition addressing the obligations Imposed by Martyn's Law. On the basis that this premises is very small having a limited occupancy, model conditions have not been included within the operating schedule save for condition 2 requiring the DPS to attend a CT Awareness Training Session.

It is not anticipated that the proposed grant of a Premises Licence will adversely affect crime and disorder or public nuisance. The premises falls outside of the Special Policy areas and is within the Northern Quarter adjacent to Ancoats and New Islington.

# a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 10)

Application to licence for ancillary purposes alcohol within a shop principally retailing desserts and lice cream. In view of the ancillary nature of the application it is considered that the potential risk of the four licensing objectives is limited.

The above is provided by way of explanation and not intended to convert into conditions

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

- In relation to the day to day operation of the premise the use of door staff will be risk assessed on an
  ongoing basis by the licence holder or premises supervisor. Where engaged, door staff shall be
  licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- 2. Alcoholic drinks may not be removed from the premises in open containers except for consumption in the hotel bedrooms or designated external areas.
- 3. Staff will receive training on matters concerning underage sales, drugs policies and operating procedures.
- 4. There shall be a zero tolerance policy in relation to drugs at the premises and there shall be regular checks by management to prevent the use of drugs by patrons. Drugs seized shall be stored securely and handed to the police.
- 5. The premise will maintain an incident and refusal log which we be available to the Greater Manchester Police and the Licensing Authority upon reasonable request.
- 6. The Designated Premises Supervisor must have attended a CT Awareness training session delivered by CTPNW-trained personnel as soon as is reasonably practicable. In all cases, within 28 days of a new Designated Premises Supervisor being named on the Licence, they must have registered to attend a course and be able to provide evidence of this if requested by a police officer or authorised officer of Manchester City Council.
- 7. CCTV shall be installed with recording facilities such recordings shall be retained for a period of 28 days (except where such retention cannot be achieved due to reasonable periods of maintenance or repair) and made available within a reasonable time upon request by the police as long as the request is in accordance with data protection principles.

#### c) Public safety

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

- 1. Staff will be trained on matters of safety, evacuation and use of emergency equipment as required.
- 2. At the end of trading the Pavement Licence area and front of the premise outside the premises, must be swept and/or washed, and litter and sweepings collected and stored in waste receptacles.
- 3. All takeaway packaging and wrappers shall clearly identify the premises, i.e. by way of company logo or name.

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

- 1. Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nulsance to nearby properties.
- 2. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

- The Challenge 25 scheme must be operated to ensure that any person who appears to be under the
  age of 25 shall provide documented proof that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall only
  comprise a passport, photo card driving licence, an EU/EEA national ID card or similar document, an
  HM Forces warrant card, a card bearing the PASS hologram, or any electronic or biometric age
  verification technology approved by the licensing authority.
- 2. The premises shall display prominent signage indicating at any point of sale that the Challenge 25 scheme is in operation.
- 3. The premises shall display prominent signage indicating at any point of sale that it is an offence to buy or attempt to buy alcohol for a person who is under 18 and for a person under the age of 18 to buy or attempt to buy alcohol.
- 4. A refusals record must be kept at the premises which details all refusals to sell alcohol. This record must include the date and time of the incident, the name of the staff member who refused the sale, and the reason the sale was refused. All entries must be made within 24 hours of the refusal. The record must be made available for inspection and copying within a reasonable time of a request by an officer of a Responsible Authority.

    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
  - Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
    - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - any piaying of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
    - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the
