The premises is a 40 - 50 cover bar and restaurant with a front and back terrace, and a commercial kitchen unit. The premises will be serving hot and cold food as well as alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. The bar will also sell alcohol for off sales to be consumed at home through in store retail, online orders, and delivery services. The premises will provide indoor entertainment for customers on site in the form of live and recorded music, as well as films. The premises will also be used for the production of artisan liqueurs, ready to drink alcoholic beverages, soft drinks and fermented produce under the guidance of a compounder's license.

Any alcoholic drinks sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made in advance ready for sale or supply in securely closed containers) is available to customers, with measures in accordance to the weights and measures act 2015; the measures are displayed in the menu, price list or other printed materials available to the customers on the premises; and where a customer does not state the measures is made aware that these measures are available

Ensure free potable water on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

To make sure staff on premises do not carry out, arrange, or participate in any irresponsible promotions of alcohol on premises, and encourage safe consumption on site.

Notice advising what forms of ID are acceptable must be displayed on the premises as well as Challenge 25 notices.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A comprehensive CCTV system shall be maintained and operated at the premises with cameras positioned both internally and externally.

Recorded CCTV images will be maintained and stored for a period of 31 days and shall be produced to the Police or Licensing Authority upon request.

Any persons left in charge of the premises must be trained in the use of any such CCTV equipment, and be able to produce CCTV images to an officer from a responsible authority upon request.

Any door staff employed at the premises shall be SIA registered, in accordance with a risk assessment to be carried out by the DPS. When employed, door staff will wear high visibility armbands.

When employed, a register of those door staff employed at the premises shall be maintained at the premises and shall include:
a. the number of door staff on duty;
B. the identity of each member of door staff on duty.

c) Public safety

A first aid box will be kept on site and stock checked regularly.

Regular safety checks shall be carried out by staff.

Liaise with Fire Authority as necessary to ensure compliance with all necessary fire regulations.

Premises will maintain an incident log book and public liability insurance.

Open containers of alcohol shall not be removed from the premises, save for consumption in any delineated external areas.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Noise from amplified music or voices shall not be such as to cause nuisance to occupants of nearby premises.

Doors and windows at the premises are to remain closed after 11pm, save for access and egress.

The external areas shall cease to be used for drinking and/or dining at 11pm daily.

Notices and appropriate signage will be placed at any entrance and exit reminding customers to leave in a quiet manner.

Sufficient toilets will be available to customers relating to venue capacity in accordance to The British Standard of Sanitary Installations 6465.

Emptying of bins and skips, and refuse collections will not take place between 11pm and 8am.

The area immediately outside the premises shall be kept clean and cleared of litter at regular intervals

e) The protection of children from harm

Challenge 25 will be in place and all staff will be trained in challenge 25 protocols with in house training and recorded documentation of training. No supply of alcohol will be given to patrons under the age of 18 and records will be kept of any refusals to those deemed under age and unable to provide identification.

The admission of children under the age of 18 to film exhibitions shall be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made:

- (a) by the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC) where the film has been classified by the board, or
- (b) by the licensing authority where no classification certificate has been granted by the BBFC, or where the licensing authority has been notified the club which holds the certificate that the licensing act 2003 applies to film.

To take action as is necessary to prevent the sale of alcohol to persons over the age of 18 intending to supply it to a person under the age of 18. The training must be given to a new member of staff before they commence employment and all staff must receive refresher training every 6 months.
