Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

Door Supervisors

Only individuals licensed by the Security Industry Authority shall be used at the premises to undertake security activities, which include guarding against: -

- a) Unauthorised access or occupation (e.g. through door supervision),
- b) Outbreaks of disorder, or
- c) Damage

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. The CCTV system shall be maintained and operated at the premises. Recorded images will be retained for 30 days.
- 2. A defined queuing system shall be implemented and operational at the premises at all times
- 3. Adequate seating shall be provided within the premises at all times.
- 4. Fire fighting equipment shall be maintained and serviced according to the manufacturers instructions on an annual basis, and such checks shall be recorded
- 5. Management shall carry out regularly Health and Safety audits, and a written record shall be kept
- 6. Adequate litter bins shall be provided
- 7. Deliveries shall only be made to the premises between 0800 and 1900
- 8. Refuse shall only be collected from the premises between 0800 and 1900
- 9. An air conditioning system shall be maintained and operational at the premises

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

- 1. Staff will use their best endeavours to ensure that customers do not congregate outside the premises.
- 2. Litter will be removed from outside the premises at regular intervals and after the close of business.
- 3. Ensure that air-conditioning or ventilation does not produce excessive noise causing nuisance to the nearest sensitive location.
