

Schedule of Licence Conditions

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The premises shall operate as an online alcohol retailer only. 2. No sales of alcohol may be made directly to the public from the premises. 3. No members of the public shall be permitted to access the premises to purchase alcohol. 4. No promotional social media communication shall be carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol at the premises or in relation to the business operation. The premises shall not condone, encourage or glamorise antisocial behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner. 5. Delivery drivers shall conduct the delivery in a manner that shall not cause a noise disturbance to the occupiers of any residential properties surrounding the delivery address. This shall include the avoidance of slamming doors, playing loud music, shouting, over-revving engines and sounding horns to signal their arrival. The driver shall turn the engine off immediately upon arrival at the delivery address and shall park considerately without causing any obstruction to the highway. 6. Staff shall be trained to deal with situations. 7. The Challenge 25 scheme shall be operated to ensure that any person who appears to under the age of 25 shall provide documented proof that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall only comprise a passport, photo card driving licence, an EU/EEA national id card or similar document, a HM Forces warrant card, a card bearing the 'PASS' hologram, or any electronic or biometric age verification technology approved by the licensing authority. 8. To ensure that persons purchasing alcohol via the online platform are over the age of 18, the company shall ensure that the customers are aware that proof of id shall be a condition of sale and must be provided prior to receipt of any alcohol. Delivery drivers shall be instructed to ensure that the end consumer is the same individual that placed the order or no delivery shall take place. 9. All members of staff shall receive alcohol related training which shall include Challenge 25 and recognising signs of intoxication. The training shall be recorded and retained by the Licence Holder and shall be made available to authorised officers on request. Refresher training shall be carried out every six months. 10. Any promotional material and/or any website homepage used as part of the business operating under this licence shall clearly state the premises licence number. For the avoidance of doubt, this shall include flyers, leaflets and business cards promoting the business. 	<p>N/A</p>	<p>Applicant</p>
