Noise from amplified music or voices shall not be such as to cause a noise nuisance to occupants of nearby residential properties.11. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.12. There shall be no external speakers.13. The supply of alcohol on the premises shall only be to a person seated, taking a table meal there and for consumption by such a person as ancillary to their meal.14. Customers must vacate all outside tables and chairs by 22:00 each evening.15. Staff shall monitor any customers smoking outside the premises on a regular basis and ensure patrons do not cause a public nuisance.16. Notices shall be displayed at any area used for smoking requesting patrons to respect the needs of local resident and use the area quietly.17. Notices shall be placed at the exit reminding both patrons and delivery drivers to act with consideration for neighbours.18. The area outside the premises shall be kept clean and tidy. Staff shall be required to remove litter associated with premises on a regular basis whilst open and shall clear any litter when the premises closes.19. The emptying of bins and refuse collections, shall not take place between 22:00 and 08:00 hours.		
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
