

## **Data and Priority Areas**

In May 2024 the Performance and Research team at Manchester City Council undertook analysis of a variety of different indicators including the following:

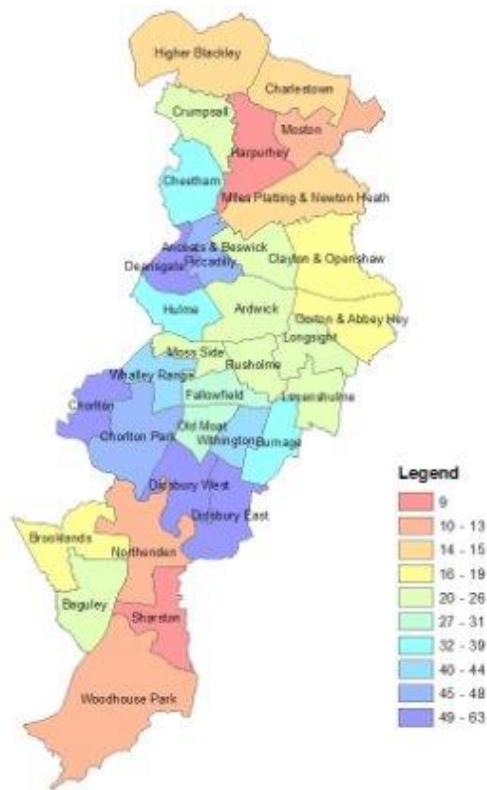
### Indices of Multiple Deprivation

- Income deprivation
- Child and Family Assessments with at least two addition factors (domestic violence, mental health, drugs and alcohol)
- Suspensions
- Free School Meals
- Good Level of Development

These indicators were combined to produce priority wards.

N.B: It is important to note that the data used is data that was available to the City Council at the Lower Super Output Areas (LSOA level). Whilst this masks some of the granularity available at LSOA level it does enable comparison.

## Ward Level - Combined Factors



The analysis highlights that the 10 priority wards are:

1. Harpurhey
2. Sharston
3. Northenden
4. Woodhouse Park
5. Moston
6. Miles Platting and Newton Heath
7. Charlestown
8. Higher Blackley
9. Clayton and Openshaw
10. Gorton and Abbey Hey
