The operating schedule which accompanies the application offers nothing in terms of enforceable conditions, which gives the impression that the applicant has a limited understanding of the Licensing Objectives, which raises concerns about how the premises will be operated.

The business wish to close at 23:00hrs each night and also stop the sale of alcohol at 23:00hrs each night.

The likely effect of the grant of the Premises Licence with such a scant operating schedule is that all 4 of the Licensing Objectives will be undermined.

We therefore ask that this application is refused.

Licensing and out of hours team (LOOHT) have assessed the likely impact of granting the new licence, taking into account a number of factors, including, the nature of the area in which the premises is located, the hours applied for and any potential risk that the granting of this new Licence could undermine the licensing objectives.

The premises is a ground floor and basement venue located on Bridge Street, Manchester. The application describes that this premises will operate as a sushi restaurant and wishes to operate until 23.00 hours, stopping serving alcohol also at 23.00 hours.

The operating schedule which accompanied the application was scant in relation to conditions which are specific, measurable and enforceable. The applicant has not used any of the model licensing conditions, which suggests limited knowledge and understanding of the 4 licensing objectives.

I have little confidence that with the offered operating schedule the licensing objectives would be upheld.
