Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

Door Supervisors

1. Only individuals licensed by the Security Industry Authority shall be used at the premises to undertake security activities, which include guarding against: -
 - (a) Unauthorised access or occupation (e.g. through door supervision),
 - (b) Outbreaks of disorder, or
 - (c) Damage,unless otherwise entitled by virtue of section 4 of the Private Security Industry Act 2001 to carry out such activities.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

1. An effective and adequate CCTV system shall be operated and maintained at the premises.
2. The maximum occupancy limit of the premises shall not be exceeded.
3. Effective and adequate interior and exterior lighting shall be installed and operated at the premises.
4. A sufficient number of staff shall be employed at the premises to ensure that queuing is reduced to a minimum.
5. Sufficient numbers and types of fire-fighting equipment shall be installed at the premises and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
6. Persons engaging in disorderly conduct shall not be permitted to enter or remain upon the premises.
7. No persons under the age of 16 shall be permitted to enter the premises after 2300.

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after hearing by the licensing authority

1. Staff shall ensure that customers do not congregate outside the premises so as to cause a noise disturbance to nearby residents.
2. The management shall ensure that the area around the premises is cleaned at regular intervals and after the close of business.
