

# General – all four licensing objectives

Locations of fire safety and other safety equipment subject to change in accordance with the requirements of the responsible authorities or following a risk assessment.

Any detail shown on the plan that is not required by the licensing plans regulations is indicative only and subject to change at any time.

The premises will operate predominantly as a restaurant set out to tables and chairs with food available throughout the trading day, subject to a permitted wind-down period before the terminal hour of service.

Waiter/waitress service shall always be available.

Alcohol shall only be sold to customers seated and partaking in a table meal.

A 30-minute drinking up time on top of the last permitted sale of alcohol to allow customers to use the toilet facilities and disperse from the premises.

# Prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV will be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the Police. The system will enable frontal identification of every person entering the premises. The system will record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days.

Recordings shall be made available immediately on request to an Authorised Officer or a Police Officer (subject to GDPR) throughout the 31-day period following any incident.

A member of staff with knowledge of the CCTV system will be present on site whilst the premises are open to the public to aid any enquiry from a Police Officer or Authorised Officer requiring recent CCTV recordings with the minimum of delay when requested.

Off sales are to be taken off the area marked on the licensed plan in sealed containers only.

## **Public Safety**

Appropriate fire safety measures will be installed and maintained as shown on the drawings accomplanying this application.

Staff will be trained in First Aid.

Adequate and appropriate first aid equipment and materials will be kept on site, regularly checked and kept in an easily accessible place for staff.

Public areas will be maintained free from obstruction and trip hazards.

All exit routes will be kept unobstructed, with non-slippery and even surfaces, free of trip hazards and clearly signed.

# **Prevention of Public Nuisance**

Refuse such as bottles will be placed into receptacles outside the premise at times that will minimise the disturbance to nearby properties.

No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that gives rise to a nuisance.

Staff shall monitor customers smoking outside the premises on a regular basis and ensure patrons do not cause a public nuisance.

The premises and immediate surrounding area shall be kept clean and free from litter at all times the premises are open to the public.

No deliveries for supplies for the restaurant (food or alcohol) will take place between 22:00 and 08:00 hours.

No collection of refuse and recyclable food waste shall take place between 22:00 and 06:00 hours. Customer notices to be displayed at all exits asking patrons to please leave the premises quietly and to respect the needs of the local residents.

# Protection of children from harm

All staff shall be aware of the law regarding the refusal of service to any person who is drunk or is underage and shall be aware of how to seek ID from anyone who appears to be underage. A 'challenge 25' policy will be adopted with proportionate and appropriate signage displayed. A "refusal to serve log" will be maintained and made available for inspection to a Police Officer or Authorised Officer, this log shall include the Date, Time, Name and Signature of the staff member who refused the sale. This log will also be signed by the DPS of the premises on a monthly basis.
