What is the decision?	To approve uplifts to fees for adult social care providers for financial year 2019/20.
	Adult Social Care commissioned contract fees are reviewed every year to help ensure that services are able to meet their obligations in relation to the increased National Living Wage, broader inflation and additional pension contributions for 2019/20.
	Increases will be met through the £4.26m National Living Wage budget and the inflationary budget.
Reasons for the decision (but excluding any exempt or confidential information)	This includes £1.026m of the £4.26m National Living Wage budget that has already been allocated to increase the homecare rate to £15.89, as part of the new Our Manchester Homecare contract. This contract will require all homecare staff to receive a minimum of the 'Manchester Living Wage' of £9.00 per hour of care.
	The increases in fees have been developed following specific consultation with providers, benchmarking with other authorities as well as wider market engagement undertaken as part of Manchester Health and Care Commissioning's Accommodated Care Programme, which has given commissioners insight into the pressures and opportunities faced by market adult social care providers.
