This will enable a detailed scope of works, concept layouts, specialist input and costs to be developed thus testing the viability of the scheme. The output of this project is that we would also expect to see a far more efficient building in terms of energy use as we propose to implement a range of measures including but not limited to replacing all existing lighting with LED, installing solar PV array on the roof of the BMX track, replacing the boilers with more efficient low carbon system and insulating the pipework.
